Please read the safety notices and these instructions before using the parasol. In this way, you will avoid injury or damage to yourself or other persons.

Unpacking

Packaging material is not a toy

Dispose plastic bags and other packaging material properly immediately after unpacking.

Children, persons with disabilities or animals cannot assess the risks posed by packaging material and may be injured or killed while playing.

Keep the instructions in a safe place

These instructions belong to the parasol. Keep this manual for future reference, so that you or other persons can access the information on safety and operation.

Missing information can lead to accidents.

Proper use

The parasol is designed to provide protection against solar radiation. Any other use, or the use at starting wind and/or rain, is not allowed. Use for other purposes may result in injuries.

Opening

Check for damage

Check the parasol for damage before opening. If you identify damage, do not open the parasol.

You may suffer injuries when opening a damaged parasol.

Only proficient persons

Only allow experienced individuals to open and close the parasol.

Inexperienced persons, persons with disabilities, or small children can injure themselves or other persons when opening or closing.

Pay attention to your surroundings

Pay attention to your surroundings when opening. You need enough free space around you when opening the parasol.

You, other persons or animals may be injured when the device is opened out.

Light protection

The parasol protects against direct sunlight in its shade. There is no protection against indirect rays of sun caused by reflections.

Therefore, wear sunscreen to protect your skin.

Closing

Secure parasol with fastening strap

Secure the parasol with the fastening strap after closing. This way you avoid unintentional opening of the parasol.

A parasol that opens unexpectedly may cause injuries.

Storage

Choose a safe place

Use the carrying case for storage. Choose a safe place for storage that is not accessible to persons with disabilities or children.

Persons may incur injuries from playing with the parasol.


Disposal

Do not disassemble parasol

Do not disassemble the parasol before disposal. You may be injured on sharp edges or pointed parts.

3. Unpacking

After unpacking, please dispose of the packing material properly. Observe the regulations for waste disposal in your area.



4. Installation

You can purchase a compatible parasol stand from FARE for the safe setup of the parasol. Please note the following information regarding the setup of the parasol:

- Only use the parasol with a compatible parasol stand and adequate ballast.
- The installation site must be level and firm. Maintain sufficient distance to heat sources and naked flames. Measure the distance so that a parasol does not come into contact with the heat source or naked flame if it accidentally topples or is knocked down.
- The parasol is constructed for use in very light wind and very light rainfall. Close the umbrella immediately with the beginning of rain and/or wind.
- > Place bottom pole into parasol stand and secure in the parasol stand





- > Place parasol in the lower pole
- > Secure parasol with locking device

5. Opening

You can open the parasol by spreading it out.




> Open the closing strap



> Keep parasol away from you, press catch and > Press catch and push runner down push slider upwards. The parasol spreads out > Secure parasol with fastening strap and the runner engages in the upper position. Due to the size of the parasol, this may require a little more strength

6. Align

You can align the parasol to face the sun.




- > Push up sleeve
- > Bend parasol in hinge direction
- > Secure parasol with sleeve

Align parasol in a straight line again:

- > Push up sleeve
- > Align parasol in a straight line
- > Push sleeve down Due to the size of the parasol, this may require a little more strength.

7. Closing

You can close the parasol mechanically.



- > Align parasol in a straight line
- Due to the size of the parasol, this may require a little more strength.

8. Storage

You should store the parasol in a dry and safe location.

Tips

- Leave the wet parasol open to dry, when there is
- You can store the dry parasol closed and secured with fastening strap in the carrying case.

9. Care

The parasol requires very little maintenance and care.

Tips

- You can use a slightly dampened cloth for the cleaning of cover. Do not use any cleaning agents as otherwise the cover becomes permeable to wa-
- A dry, soft cloth is suitable for the upper and lower poles.

10. Disposal

If the parasol has become worn-out, you can dispose of it with household waste. Find out about the regulations applicable to your local area at the time of disposal.
