## 1. Safety

Please read the safety advice and these instructions before using the Travelmate Camper.

*In this way, you will avoid injury or damage to yourself or other persons. We refer to the Travelmate Camper parasol and umbrella as an umbrella below.*

### Unpacking

#### Packaging material is not a toy

Dispose of plastic bags and other packaging material properly immediately after unpacking.

*Children, persons with disabilities or animals cannot assess the risks posed by packaging material and may be injured or killed while playing.*

#### Keep the instructions in a safe place

These instructions belong to the umbrella. Keep this manual for future reference, so that you or other persons can access the information on safety and operation.

*Missing information can lead to accidents.*

#### Proper use

The umbrella without shaft is designed to protect against rainfall and the umbrella with shaft is designed to protect against sun rays. Any other use, even in extreme weather situations, is not permitted.

*Use for other purposes may result in injuries.*

### Opening

#### Check for damage

Check the umbrella for damage before opening. If you notice any damage, do not open the umbrella.

*A damaged umbrella can injure you when opening it.*

#### Only proficient persons

Only allow proficient persons to open or close the umbrella.

*Inexperienced persons, persons with disabilities, or small children can injure themselves or other persons when opening or closing.*

### Pay attention to your surroundings

Pay attention to your surroundings when opening. You need enough free space around you when opening the umbrella.

*You, other persons or animals may be injured when the device is opened out.*

### Light protection

The umbrella protects against direct sunlight in its shade. There is no protection against indirect rays of sun caused by reflections.

*Therefore, wear sunscreen to protect your skin.*

### Closing

#### Secure with the closing strap

Secure the umbrella with the closing strap after closing. This prevents accidental opening of the umbrella.

*An umbrella opening unexpectedly can cause injuries.*

### Storage

#### Choose a safe place

Use the carrying case for storage. Choose a safe place for storage that is not accessible to persons with disabilities or children.

*Playing with the umbrella can cause injury to persons.*

### Disposal

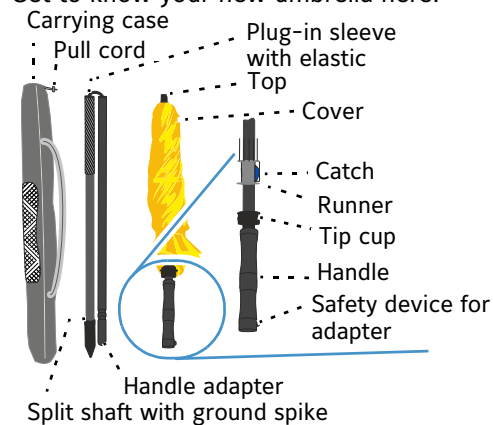
*Do not dismantle the umbrella*

Do not dismantle the umbrella before disposal.

*You may be injured on sharp edges or pointed parts.*

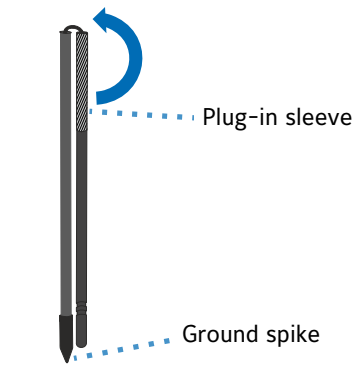

## 4. Set up

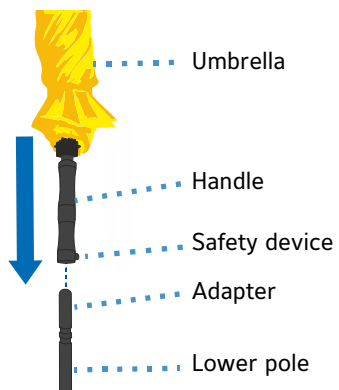
When using the umbrella as sun protection, please note the following information when setting up the umbrella and shaft:

- Suitable base: You should be able to insert the shaft with the ground spike so deeply that you achieve appropriate stability for the umbrella. Our recommendation: Also use the FARE ground spike 8939 if you are not able to insert the shaft deep enough in the ground.
- Distance: Maintain sufficient distance to heat sources and naked flames. Measure the distance so that a umbrella does not come into contact with the heat source or naked flame if it accidentally topples or is knocked down.
- Shaft: Do not use a defective shaft. Do not bend or fold the shaft. The shaft may break with overloading or parts of the fibreglass may come loose. Fibreglass parts are sharp and can penetrate the skin and cause injuries.
- No tools: Only exert gentle pressure on the lower part of the shaft during set-up. Do not use any tools.
- Wind: The umbrella is designed for use in calm conditions. Close the umbrella during high wind conditions, wind gusts or other adverse weather conditions





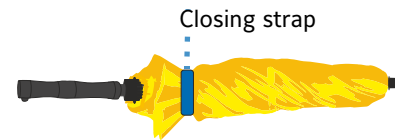
- ▶ Slide parts of the shaft into each other. Ensure secure connection of the parts in the plug-in sleeve.
- ▶ Place shaft with the ground spike in the ground



- ▶ Place umbrella at the handle into the adapter on the shaft. Ensure the safety device engages.

## 5. Open

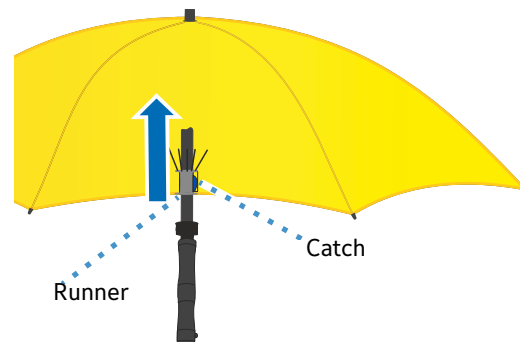
You can open the umbrella by spreading it out.



- ▶ Open the closing strap



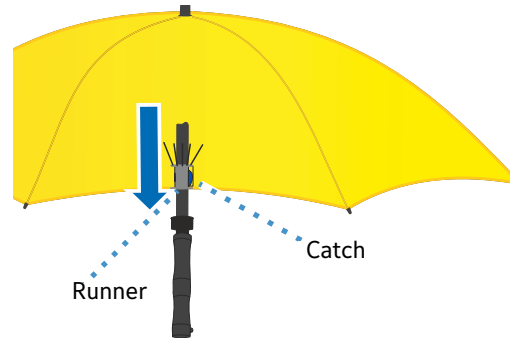
- ▶ Pull the tip-cup down



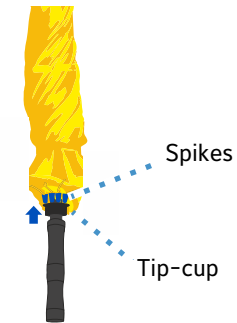
- ▶ Press catch and push slider upwards.. The umbrella spreads out and the slider engages in the upper position.

## 6. Close

You can close the umbrella mechanically.



- ▶ Press catch and push slider down



- ▶ "Collect" spikes around the tip-cup and push tip-cup up. The spikes are now protected.
- ▶ Secure the umbrella with the closing strap
- ▶ Press safety device on the handle and remove parasol from the shaft
- ▶ Take hold of the shaft at the lower end and pull from the ground
- ▶ Take hold of both parts of the shaft near the plug-in sleeve, pull apart and place side by side for transport
- ▶ Stow parasol and shaft in carrying case

## 7. Storage

You should keep the umbrella dry and in a safe place.

### Tips

- Leave a wet umbrella open to dry.
- You can safely store the dry umbrella closed, with fastening strap in the carrying case.

## 8. Care

The umbrella requires little care.

### Tips

- You can use a slightly dampened cloth for the cover. Do not use any cleaning agents as otherwise the cover becomes permeable to water.
- A dry, soft cloth is suitable for the upper and lower poles.

## 9. Disposal

When the umbrella has served its time, you can dispose of it in the household waste. Find out about the regulations applicable to your local area at the time of disposal.
